Responsibilities

- 9. Assist the Treasurer and Travel Director with the collection and reconciliation of fees.
- 10. Work with the Treasurer to review, issue and reconcile refunds.
- 11. Assist the Treasurer in preparing adequate working papers for the external Auditor
- 12. Report current registration numbers to OMHA when requested.
- 13. With the assistance of the Travel Director, House League Director and Director of Coaching Development, ensure team staff and parents complete required courses and obtain needed certifications.
- 14. Establish and maintain a convenient registration system and schedule for all BRDMHA members.
- 15. Complete various forms and remit to OMHA (with payments if required).
- 16. Work to grow registration in BRDMHA
- 17. Provide monthly and annual report to BRDMHA Executive during our Monthly and Annual General Meeting
