2023-2024 Scholarship- General Information

This year, the BRDMHA scholarship committee will award 2- \$1000 scholarships to graduating students who have been accepted to a post-secondary program as a full-time student. These awards are based on overall merit of the students and are open to all University or Collage bound students.

OBJECTIVE:

Our purpose is to recognize the outstanding contributions made by our graduating BRDMHA players This process evaluates the academic achievements well as extra-curricular activities and the community service of our students. The deserving students are those that excel in these areas and improve the community.

CRITERIA FOR SELECTION & EVALUATION:

Those wishing to apply must fill out an application. They will be available @ www.brdmha.com
Candidate must be a current full-time student and have been a player with BRDMHA for at least 3yrs.
The application must be submitted in the last year (Grade 12)
Candidate must successfully complete the requirements necessary for acceptance to Univ. or College.
Candidate must submit an application letter stating why they feel the should be considered.
Three (3) reference letters are to be provided (*employer, parish, neighbours, teachers etc*)
All applications are due in the BRDMHA Office (*upstairs Rink A*) by **April 15 2023 by 8pm**

Please make an appointment with the Secretary to drop off your application in person.

Applications received after the due date and time will NOT be accepted.

Incomplete applications can not be considered.

Any false or misleading information discovered during our verification process will result in disqualification.

Activities can only be credited in ONE category of your submission.

If a committee member knows the applicant, they will be excused from evaluating that application.

EVALUATION CRITERIA:

Academic Achievement (*maximum 10 points*)

The applicant's marks for ALL courses taken at their high school are to be obtained through the guidance office. They are to be emailed to **Shannon Philpott** secretary@brdmha.com

Points are awarded based on overall average:

>	94.50%	10 pts
>	89.50%	9 pts
>	84.50%	8 pts
>	79.50%	7 pts
>	74.50%	6 pts
>	69.50%	5 pts
>	64.50%	4 pts
<	64.50%	3 pts

Extra-Curricular SCHOOL Involvement (maximum 10 points)

This category is based on extra-curricular activity involvement within the school such as teams, clubs etc. (Note: Activities performed as part of academic course-work cannot be considered eg. Muskoka Trip)

Extra-Curricular COMMUNITY Involvement (maximum 10 points)

This category is based on extra-curricular activity within the community. Please make sure each activity is itemized with dates, type of activity and signature with contact information in order to be credited for the hours. Minimum **80 hours** is required.

Extraordinary Time Commitments (maximum 3 points)

This category is based on the time spent outside of extra-curricular and community involvement. Eg. Employment, care giving responsibilities, travel sports.

(Note: Must provide dates, description of activity and a contact name, phone# & signature)

Application Letter (maximum 10 points)

Each applicant must submit an application letter telling us about them selves and future goals. Addressing why they should receive a scholarship, his/her/their contributions to hockey, what has the game of hockey meant to him/her/they.

Record of Minor Hockey Involvement (maximum 10 points)

This Category is based on the time you have given back to minor hockey.

Eg. Volunteering, coaching, officiating, Time keeping, etc

Reference Letters (maximum 7 points)

Three reference letters must be provided (*teacher, employer, priest, coach etc*)
